






NBI: BETTER CONNECTIVITY FOR BETTER SERVICES

Through the National Data Transmission Backbone Infrastructure (NBI), NITA-U has laid an Optical Fibre Cable based Network



IMPACT OF THE NBI

With more Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) and Local Government locations (LG) connected onto the NBI, the cost of internet bandwidth has progressively reduced.

High speed connectivity between Government offices has improved communication and information sharing.






NBI/EGI has also been extended to connect 16 universities and research institutions and 5 hospitals to facilitate research, learning and telemedicine.
